**DYNAMO 100% Organic** Stubble Turnip seed

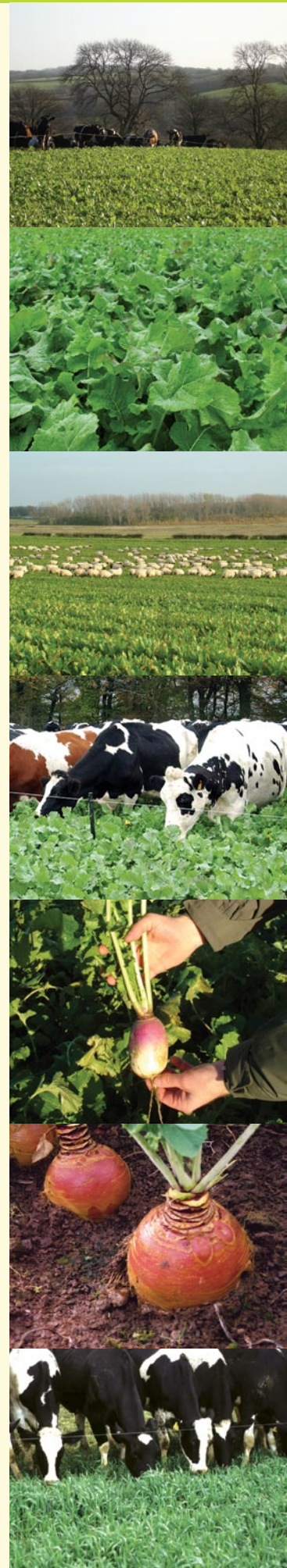
**DYNAMO** gives high yields of forage with a medium sized bulb. A proven variety, grown in the U.K. Sown on its own or in our forage mixtures.
